

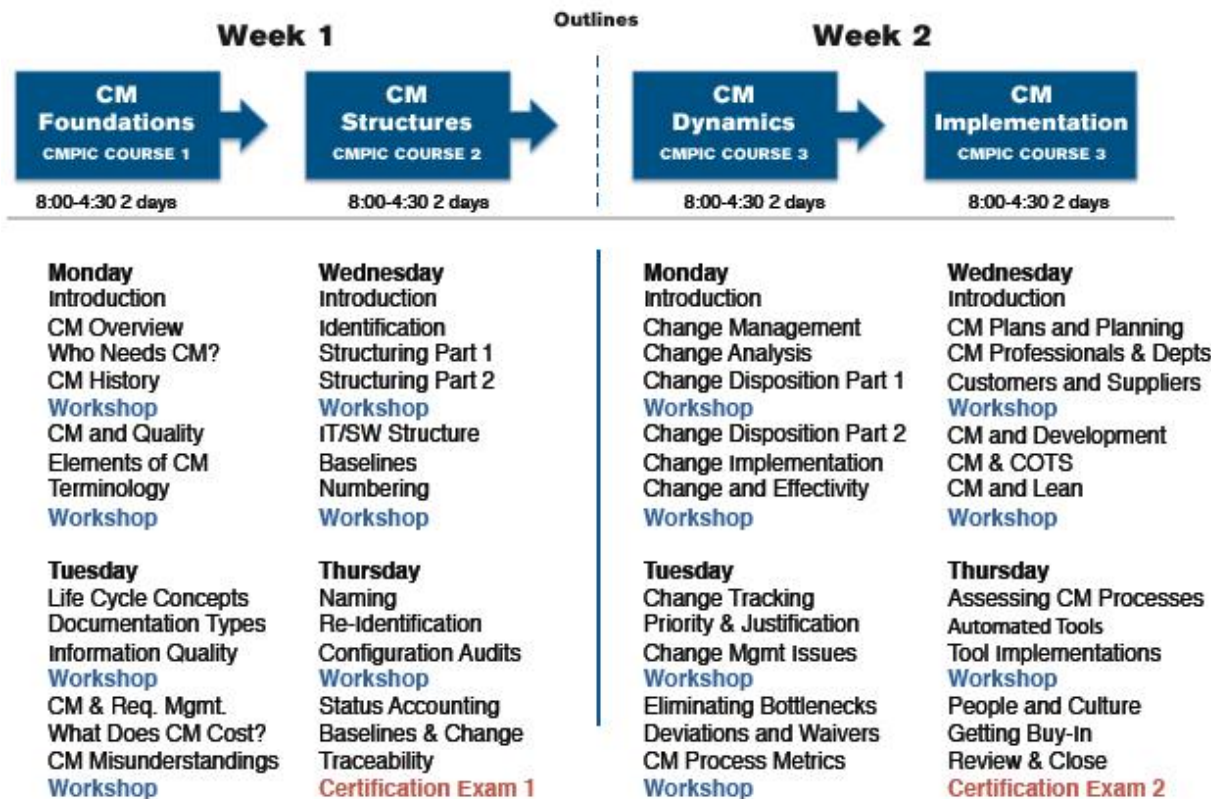


Configuration Management Principles and Implementation Certification (CMPIC Courses 1-4)
